

Murdered Journalist Nimalarajan's investigation report:

Published in the North and East of Sri Lanka.

The investigation report prepared by the Redress and the ITJPSL on the death of murdered journalist M.Nimalarajan has been published in Sri Lanka and is being distributed to everyone. The European Union has funded the production of this report.

It is noteworthy that the report contains the investigation report on the murder of murdered journalist Nimalarajan and information related to the murdered and disappearance of journalist.

The report has been published in the Vavunia, Batticaloa, Trincomalee, Mannar, and Jaffna districts of the Northern and Eastern Provinces and has been distributed to the general public since last week.

On October 19, 2000, while curfew was in effect in Jaffna, gunmen entered Nimalarajan's house, opened fire on him, and threw a grenade inside the house.

While Nimalarajan was murdered in the attack, his father, mother, and son-in-law were injured.

It is noteworthy that media organizations such as the Eastern Journalists' Forum, the Jaffna Press Club, the Sri Lanka Professional Web Journalists' Association, Trincomalee Media Society and the Batti Press Club have continued to raise their voices for the murdered journalists, as justice has not been served for the past twenty-five years since the murder of Nimalarajan.
